The organization develops high quality curriculum and programs that are delivered directly to youth, strategically connects partners and resources across the city to create learning systems that can effect change on a wider scale, and provides consulting services to other nonprofits and organizations, including professional development, curriculum design and technical assistance. Big Thought is a nationally-recognized leader in arts education, after school programming, summer learning, juvenile justice, learning systems, trauma-informed methodology, educational equity, and social and emotional learning. Mathes has been a member of the Big Thought Board since 2016 and has served as Chair-Elect, Board Governance Committee Chair and Communications Committee Chair.
